We ask that all entries abide by these few rules:

Throwing or passing of articles from the line of march, such as candy, balloons, gum, literature, use of water propulsion devices, etc. is STRICTLY PROHIBITED, such action may cause an accident by scaring a horse or enticing a child into the line of march. The use of Alcoholic Beverages in the staging, parade and disbursing areas before, during and after the Parade is <u>STRICTLY PROHIBITED</u>.

Multiple motorized entries will be limited to a <u>MAXIMUM</u> of ten (10) vehicles and are asked to parade two (2) absent

asked to parade two (2) abreast.

No signs, placards or literature pertaining to political candidates or persons running for office will be allowed to be on parade entries or passed out on the Parade route.

Parade floats: Decorate material shall be noncombustible or flame retardant material.

Floats and towing apparatus must have a minimum 2-A, 10-B-C portable fire

All unites are asked to pay close attention to the parade monitors on the Parade route and keep properly spaced. No more than thirty (30) yards between units. In order to clean the streets in a timely manner, equestrians are asked to exit the staging

area by 2PM.

Your cooperation in abiding by these rules will help make our celebration a safe and pleasurable occasion.
