Location and Time:

All FLOATS must be there at 8:00am.

Division SH on 1st St. between Orange Ave. and D Ave. at 9:00am.

Division 1 on J Ave. between 1st and 2nd St. at 9:00am.

Division 2 on I Ave. between 1st and 2nd St. at 9:00am.

Division 3 on H Ave. between 1st and 2nd St. at 9:30am.

Division 4 on H Ave. between 2nd and 3rd St. at 9:30am.

Division 5 on G Ave. between 1st and 2nd St. at 10:00am.

Division 6 on G Ave. between 2nd and 3rd St. at 10:00am.

Division 7 on F Ave. between 1st and 2nd St. at 10:30am.

Division 8 on F Ave. between 2nd and 3rd St. at 10:30am.

All FLOATS must be there at 8:00am.

We ask that all entries abide by these few rules:

1. **Throwing or passing** of articles from the line of march, such as candy, balloons, gum, literature, **use of water propulsion devices**, etc. is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**, such action may cause an accident by scaring a horse or enticing a child into the line of march.
2. **The use of Alcoholic Beverages in the staging, parade and disbursing areas before, during and after the Parade is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
3. Multiple motorized entries will be limited to a **MAXIMUM** of ten (10) vehicles and are asked to parade two (2) abreast.
4. **No signs, placards or literature** pertaining to political candidates or persons running for office will be allowed to be on parade entries or passed out on the Parade route.
5. **Parade floats:** Decorate material shall be **noncombustible or flame retardant** material. Floats and towing apparatus must have a **minimum 2-A, 10-B-C portable fire extinguisher**.
6. All units are asked to pay close attention to the parade monitors on the Parade route and keep properly spaced. **No more than thirty (30) yards between units.**
7. In order to clean the streets in a timely manner, equestrians are asked to exit the staging area by **2PM**.

Your cooperation in abiding by these rules will help make our celebration a safe and pleasurable occasion.
