### CADETS:

- Bring your **FULL SEA BAG** to this OCTOBER DRILL - **TAKING PICTURES FOR WINTER PHOTO**
- Course work ( a minimum of 2 assignments)
- Haircuts must be within regulations
- Clean shaven
- DRILL Dues (\$7.50 day or \$15 weekend)

If you arrive to drill unprepared or out of uniform you may be sent home. Be mindful you are on a military base wearing authentic military uniforms and must wear them with pride and due respect. We the staff and your cadet leadership are not doing you any favors by allowing participate at drill without following Sea Cadet regulations related to appearance and behavior. Our goal is to prepare you at home base so when you go to trainings or events you are well informed and are a positive reflection of the Naval Sea Cadet Program as well as yourself.

### BASE ACCESS

If you have turned in your base access documents you are on the base access list.

*When there are issues at the gate it is because:*

1. The POA from NAB (our base) did not forward our base access list to the Naval Base North Island
2. North Island Base is the official security office responsible for sending out all base access lists to the intended base on the date of drill.
3. On occasion only page one is printed of our base access list and therefore they have an incomplete list.
4. You are attending orientation and not on the list.

You **MUST** pass the PRT at drill weekend or your orders to attending winter training will not be approved.

**NOTE:** If you pass PRT with the minimum at drill there is a chance you will **FAIL** at winter training. There is no refund for cadets that fail the PRT at training. You may stay and finish the training however you will not receive credit.

Also those cadets attending recruit training (boot camp) will need to complete the BMR course book. There are 15 assignments.
